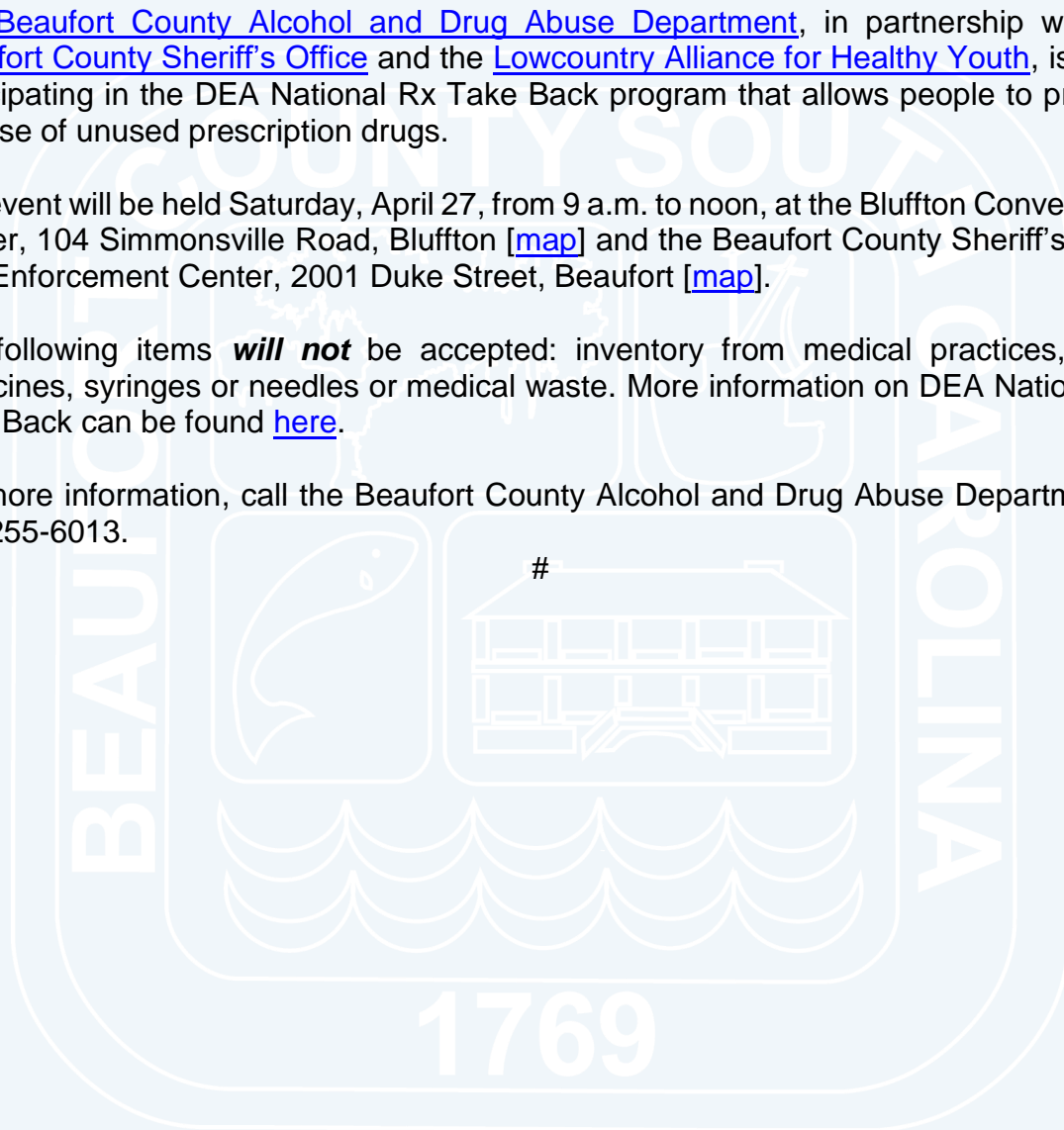
Beaufort County Offers Two Locations for Residents to Properly Dispose of Prescription Drugs On April 27

The [Beaufort County Alcohol and Drug Abuse Department](#), in partnership with the [Beaufort County Sheriff's Office](#) and the [Lowcountry Alliance for Healthy Youth](#), is again participating in the DEA National Rx Take Back program that allows people to properly dispose of unused prescription drugs.
